GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATION

- This competition is open to diploma/degree Engineering, architecture students and professionals. There is NO REGISTRATION FEE for participation. Participants must submit file containing their personal details and poster in link - <https://forms.gle/sctcDwZYMQBQeTKQ7>
- Age limits: 15 to 30 years, participants need to upload a scanned copy of their Aadhar card and college ID/ Institute ID / Work place ID.
- The student participants shall mention their name, college name, year/semester of study, date of birth. Rest participants to mention Institute / work place, Position, Date of birth. Wrong entries can lead to a discrepancy in the generation of e-certificates, Re-issue of participation certificate is not possible.
- Plagiarism limited to 25% only, (more of own ideas creativity).
- The poster should be in 4:3 ratio, Size A3 Paper.
- The posters should be digitally made.
- Strictly individual participation.
- No trademarked or copyrighted images or phrases should be used. IWWA Mumbai Centre shall not be responsible for copywrite violation, if any.
- The poster should focus on the theme and should have the theme and slogan written on the top front page of the poster
- Participants can use illustrator, adobe photoshop and any platform, final submission should be PDF format. Poster PDF file should upload in the above link.
